How about adding this on page 208:

Margaret Bourke-White caused a sensation wherever she went, and as I was working on this book I began to wonder now if Lieutenant Meyer ever met the glamorous photographer. Then I came upon one of his wartime diaries that had been missing. In an entry my father made late in December 1942 I found a reference to Scottish nurses whose ship had been torpedoed; and a few pages on he mentioned having coffee with General Adkinson. No mention, though, of Margaret Bourke-White.
